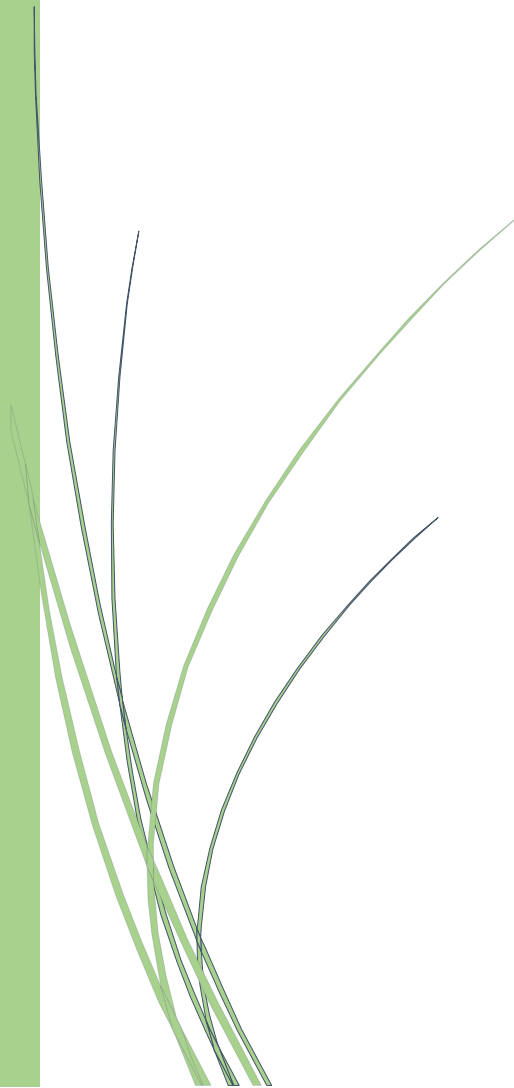

What We Provide

To make your packing easier, we supply a selection of essentials to get your stay started comfortably:

Linens & Bedding: cozy bedding for all sleep spaces, plus bath linens allocated at two towels per person, per stay. To ensure a peaceful, uninterrupted stay, we do not enter the RV to switch out linens or towels during standard 2-to-3 night stays. For Extended Stays: If you are staying with us for a longer duration, we are happy to accommodate you! If not already arranged, please message us through the app to make arrangements for fresh linens and towel change-outs after your first 3 nights.

Kitchen Supplies: basic kitchen essentials like pots, pans, plates, and utensils along with fresh kitchen linens. We also include a starter supply of cooking spray, salt & pepper, trash can liners, and basic coffee supplies.

Cleaning Supplies: Basic cleanup essentials to help keep the space tidy during your stay. There is a utility closet when you first come in and cleaners located under the kitchen and bath sinks.

Bathroom Comforts: We provide some initial supplies of the bathroom basics, including a hair dryer, cotton swabs/balls, hand lotion, hand soap, facial tissues and makeup wipes. Toilet paper is fully supplied and there is a night light to help navigate at night. We also include a basic first aid kit for any minor bumps or scrapes.

RV Systems Guide

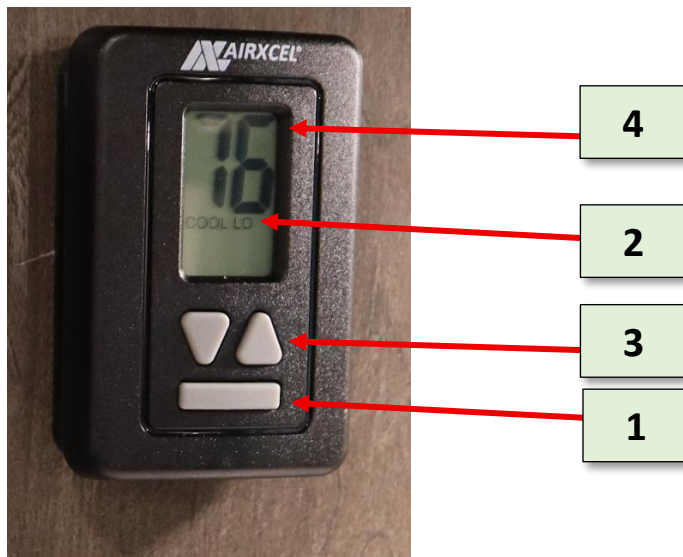
Heating & Air Conditioning

The thermostat to control the heating and air conditioning for the unit is located on the left wall next to the sink in the kitchen. This thermostat controls the heat (transmitted via wall vents near the floor) and the air conditioning (transmitted via ceiling vents).

The bedroom also has a thermostat on the wall near the door that controls only the unit in that room (unit is located above the bed). It can be used as a fan or an air conditioner, but does not provide heat. The controls work the same as the thermostat in the kitchen.

To use the digital thermostats:

- 1 Press the long button to turn the system on/off.
- 2 Continue pressing the long button to scroll through the heating and cooling options that display under the temperature. *To help control electricity costs, please use an "auto" option once you decide on cool lo/hi or heat lo/hi*
- 3 Once you are on the desired option, use the down arrow or up arrow
- 4 Temperature



Ceiling Vent Fans

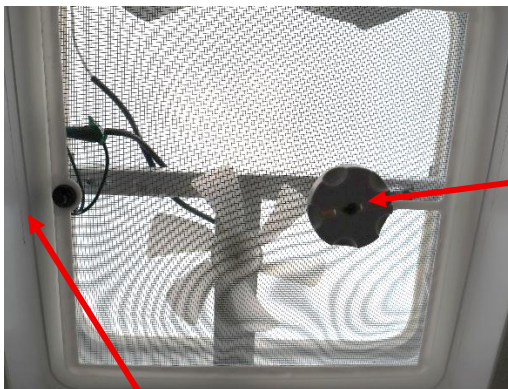
There are two ceiling vent fans that pull air from the unit to the outside.

The one in the kitchen is operated by a wall switch next to the heating/cooling thermostat.



- *Fan On 1-2-3-4* – push once to turn on and push repeatedly to change the speed of the fan. The vent will automatically open when you turn on the fan.
- *Fan Off* – push once to turn the fan off. The vent will automatically close when you turn off the fan.
- *Vent Open* – push once to open the vent without using the fan.
- *Vent Close* – push once to close the vent.

The one in the bathroom is located above the left sink and is operated by twisting the knob to open/close and then pushing the button to start/stop. To keep the air fresh and control moisture, please run the bathroom vent fan during every shower. If the ceiling controls are too high, a step stool is tucked away on the left of the dining table by the front door.

Fireplace

The living room features a remote-controlled electric fireplace. You can use it to add cozy heat on chilly nights, or turn on just the flames for visual ambiance. Use the remote or manual buttons on the unit to turn it on/off, adjust the heat level, or change the flame settings. For peace of mind and to protect the RV's electrical system, please turn the fireplace completely off whenever you leave the unit or go to sleep. Below is a picture of the manual controls (located in the upper right of the fireplace) and the remote. The icons for the controls are the same on both.



- *Red Button/Circle with line* – On/Off
- *Flames* – Adjusts flame brightness and/or colors
- *Wavy Lines* – turns heat on/off or cycles through low/high heat
- *Clock with arrow* – sets a shut-off timer
- *Logs/Ember bed* – scrolls through rock colors under the flames
- *Down/Up Arrows* – used to lower/raise options like temperature or timer

Roku TVs (Guest Mode)

Unit 1 features TVs running in Roku Guest Mode, which allows you to securely log into your personal streaming accounts (Netflix, Hulu, Prime Video, etc.). Your data is entirely private and automatically wipes when you check out.

The living room features an all-in-one Smart Roku TV - just use the Roku remote to power on the TV and navigate the welcome screen.

The bedroom features a TV with an external Roku device attached – just use the TV remote to turn it on, then use the Roku remote to navigate the welcome screen.

How to use Roku Guest Mode

Step 1: Welcome & Setup: you will see a welcome screen, simply follow the instructions on the screen. The bedroom sometimes has a slight delay, so please allow it a moment when navigating.

Step 2: Once you are all set up with your checkout date, the TV layout will open up. You can login your favorite apps or download new ones freely.

Step 3: On your chosen checkout date, the Roku will automatically log you out, erase your viewing history, and completely wipe your login credentials for your privacy. No need to do anything else.

Kitchen - Large Appliances



Gas Stove/Oven

The kitchen is fully equipped for your favorite meals! The stove runs on propane and features a built-in electronic igniter, so no external matches or lighters are needed.

The knobs for the burners are located on the front left and front right. The oven knob is located on the front in the center.



To use the burner knobs - push in and turn to the right until the flame ignites, then adjust to the desired flame height. ***Do not cook over the open flames without a pan/pot.***

To use the oven knob - keep the oven door closed, push in and turn to the right until you hear the oven ignite, then adjust to the desired temperature (located on the knob itself).

⚠️ Propane Safety Notice

Because the kitchen operates on a sensitive RV propane system, safety is our top priority!

- ***Double-Check Your Dials:*** Please be absolutely sure to turn all stove burners and the oven dials to the ***completely OFF position*** immediately after you finish cooking.
- ***Prevent Leaks:*** Verifying that the dials are completely off prevents accidental propane leaks and keeps the rig safe and comfortable for everyone.

Gas Stove/Oven, cont.

The range includes an overhead exhaust hood that can be used for extra lighting and/or an exhaust fan. The two buttons on the right control the light and fan. We do suggest you use the exhaust fan whenever you are cooking to clear out heat, steam, and cooking aromas to keep the RV fresh.



Microwave

The kitchen features a full-size, residential-style microwave for your convenience. To keep it working perfectly and looking fresh, please remember these three simple rules:

- No Metal Allowed: Please do not place any metal objects, aluminum foil, or twist-ties inside the microwave, as this can cause sparks and damage the appliance.
- Cover Your Food: Always use a microwave-safe cover, paper towel, or lid when heating food to prevent messy splatters.
- Quick Cleanup: If a spill or splash does happen, please wipe it up right away to keep the kitchen clean for the rest of your stay.

❄️ Refrigerator/Freezer

To keep your food cold and protect the RV's specialized latching system, please follow these simple steps when opening and closing the doors:

How to Open: Locate the small hand-hold cubbies (found on the top of or under the doors). Place your hand inside the cubby and press the release button to open the door.

How to Close (Left Side First): The refrigerator features a special sealing mechanism. Always close the left-side door first, ensuring the latch guide slides perfectly into its slot. Then, close the right-side door.

Listen for the Latch: Push each door firmly until you hear it click or latch. This tells you the locking button has safely re-engaged.

Stopping the Beeping: If you hear the refrigerator start beeping, it means a door is not sealed. Simply open both doors, close them firmly in order (left, then right), and push to make sure they latch tight!

Kitchen - ☕ Coffee Station & 🍞 Small Appliances

We want you to feel right at home! The kitchen features several small appliances on the counter for your morning routine and overall enjoyment:

- 12-Cup Drip Coffee Maker: located right next to the sink for easy filling. Simply use the carafe to fill and then pour water into the back reservoir for brewing.
- Starter Coffee Supply: we are happy to provide a starter supply of filters, coffee grounds, sugar, powdered creamer, and Sweet'N Low to get your morning started right! The filters and coffee grounds are above the sink and the rest of the supplies are on the right counter.
- On-The-Go Courtesy Cups: taking your morning coffee with you? We provide complimentary disposable travel cups with lids (allotted at 1 cup per person, per day) for your convenience!
- Countertop Ice Maker: to make ice, simply open the lid, remove the ice basket, pour water into the reservoir using the water pitcher under the counter (do not fill above the MAX line), replace the ice basket, close the lid and then push "On" to start the unit. It will take approximately 8-10 minutes to finish the cycle. Repeat as needed, emptying the basket as it fills.
- Ice Storage Bin: since countertop ice makers do not keep ice frozen permanently, we provide a dedicated ice bin in the freezer. Empty your fresh ice into this bin and store it in the freezer to keep a fresh supply available.
- 4-Slice Bagel-Size Toaster: features extra-wide slots so you can easily toast thick bagels or artisan bread.



RV Bathroom & Plumbing Rules

Because this is a 5th wheel, the plumbing runs on a specialized RV septic system. Following these rules ensures a comfortable stay and keeps the plumbing working flawlessly!

The Golden Rules of the Toilet

RV-Safe Paper Only: Please only use the specific toilet paper provided in the bathroom. Standard home toilet paper will clog the system.

Never Flush the Following: Absolutely do not flush wet wipes, baby wipes, paper towels, tissues, or feminine hygiene products. A dedicated trash can is provided next to the toilet.

Where to Find Extras: We supply a starter roll, plus 3 extra rolls stored under the bathroom sink.

Running Low? If you need more toilet paper during your stay, simply message us through the app as soon as you open that last backup roll! We will bring you extra rolls.



Shower & Hot Water Guide

The shower features a premium multi-function system, allowing you to choose between a rainfall head, full-body jets, or a convenient handheld sprayer.

Water Pressure: The RV runs on a private well system, so water pressure should be good as long as you are not running multiple sinks while attempting to shower.

Hot Water Management: The hot water is supplied by an RV water heater, which holds a smaller volume than a residential house. There should be plenty of hot water for a normal, thorough wash and rinse. Long, lingering showers are not recommended to prevent cold water mid-rinse. One benefit to the small tank is that it does heat up quickly, so you do not need to wait too long between multiple people showering. We would suggest a 15-minute wait between showers to ensure the next person has hot water.

Moisture Control: Remember to open the ceiling vent fan above the sink and turn it on during every shower to clear out the steam.

House Rules

To ensure a wonderful experience for you and to keep the area serene, we kindly ask all guests to respect the following guidelines:

 Smoke & Vape Free: Smoking and vaping of any kind are strictly prohibited inside the RV and on the immediate property

 No Guest Pets: While you may spot our friendly outdoor cats roaming the property, the inside of the RV is strictly a pet-free zone. This rule helps us keep the unit impeccably clean and allergen-free for all future guests!

 Quiet Hours (10:00 PM – 8:00 AM): Please keep outdoor noise to a minimum during these hours to respect us and our neighbors.

 No Events: Large gatherings, parties, and commercial photography or filming are not permitted.

 Child Supervision: Children under the age of 18 must be supervised at all times around the property and inside the RV.

 Flexible Arrivals & Departures: Standard check-in is 3:00 PM and check-out is 11:00 AM.

- *Late Check-In*: Late arrivals are perfectly fine with no extra fees! We just ask that you kindly notify us in advance so we know when to expect you.
- *Early Check-In or Late Check-Out*: Early arrival or late departures may be possible by prior arrangement/approval and are dependent on availability. Both may be subject to additional fees which will be shared when arrangements are approved.

Outdoor & Property Guidelines

We want you to fully enjoy our beautiful rural setting! To ensure privacy for everyone, keep the land pristine, and maintain safety, guests are asked to remain within their own designated area and respect the following guidelines:

 Outbuildings, Pool & Property Trails: The pool, main house grounds, and all outbuildings are completely private and off-limits to guests. You are very welcome to use the trail directly behind the RV for walks! We just ask that you only venture up to the posted sign showing where the trail ends to respect privacy boundaries.

 Property Trails: Guests are welcome to use the trail directly behind the RV for walks. We just ask that you only venture up to the posted sign showing where the trail ends to respect the privacy of our neighbors.

 Chicken Coop: We have an enclosed chicken coop on the property. For the safety and stress levels of our birds, please do not approach or feed the chickens.

 Property Cats: You will likely see our 3 friendly outdoor cats roaming around the property. They love to say hello, but please do not allow any cats inside the RV at any time to keep the unit clean and allergen-free.

 Trash & Wildlife Safety: To avoid attracting local wildlife, all trash should be securely bagged and placed inside the outside bin near the front of the RV. All food should be stored inside the RV or your vehicle. Guests should avoid leaving anything outside that may attract wildlife (e.g. food wrappers, cans, etc.).

 Firepit Fun: You are welcome to enjoy the firepit behind the RV. Please only burn sticks, pine needles, or standard firewood. Absolutely no accelerants (like lighter fluid or gasoline) are allowed. Local firewood can be purchased roadside from many residents (be sure to take cash) and from some gas stations.

 ATVs, UTVs & other Off-Road Vehicles: If you brought ATVs, UTVs or ORVs, they must remain on the driveway only. Off-riding on the grass, or property trails is not permitted. Guests may access the nearby public land/trails for riding.

 Weapons & Hunting: Hunting, target practice, and any weapon discharge are strictly prohibited anywhere on the property. Please be sure to

 - Cadillac, about 40 mins – Family Farm and Home, Harbor Freight, Ace Hardware, Home Depot, Tractor Supply Co
- **Closest Pharmacy:** it is a significant drive to a 24-hour pharmacy. You would have to go to larger cities like Mt Pleasant, Saginaw or Grand Rapids. For regular pharmacies, we have:
 - Houghton Lake/Prudenville, about 30 mins – Walmart, Walgreens
 - Grayling, about 30 mins – Family Fare Pharmacy
 - Cadillac, about 40 mins – Meijer, Walmart

Outdoor & Recreation Needs

- Firewood:
 - Roadside Stands – there are many roadside stands as you drive into some of the nearby cities. They operate on the honor system and you need to take exact cash to place in the provided money box.
 - The closet is located on N Star City Road. Turn right out of our driveway and then turn right at Moorestown Rd. Go about 1.5 miles to N Star City Rd and you will see a sign for firewood on your right. Turn there and then go down about ½ mile and you will see the stand on the left. They sell bundles for \$10-\$25 depending on the type of wood you purchase. Below is a picture from June 2026 showing their setup/prices. The \$10 bundles are on the left.



- The next closest are located on 7 Mile Rd, on the way to Lake City. Turn right out of our driveway and then turn right at Moorestown Rd. Go about 5 miles to 7 Mile Rd, turn left at the stop sign. There are usually one or two on this road (left and right side) before you get to M-55. Just watch for the signs. Prices start at \$5 and go up from there depending on quantity/type of wood. Please note the \$5 bundles are smaller than the \$10 bundles mentioned under the first option above.

- Firewood cont.
 - Gas stations/hardware stores – several local gas stations and some local hardware stores will have seasonal campfire bundles for sale. These are all located in nearby Lake City, Houghton Lake/Prudenville, Grayling or Cadillac. We are unable to maintain a list of locations and prices since they change often. They are usually more expensive than the roadside stands.
- Public Boat Launches: we suggest using the Michigan Boating Facility Finder (MiBFF) to locate local access sites for rivers and lakes. Go to the MI-DNR website for more details - <https://www.michigan.gov/dnr> (or see QR code below)
- State Parks or State Recreation Areas:
 - For details on local parks, hiking/biking trails, public beaches, etc., we suggest using <https://www.michigan.gov/dnr> (or see QR code below)
 - For ATV/ORV trails, the nearest trailhead is located less than 5 minutes north of our property. Turn left out of our driveway and go north about 2.4 miles. The trailhead is on your right and has a sign for N Missaukee Trailhead. For other trailheads, we suggest using <https://www.michigan.gov/dnr>

- Closest Gas Stations:
 - Moorestown, about 2 mins – Whipple's offers Diesel, Regular and Recreational Gas
 - Lake City, about 25 mins – multiples options
 - Houghton Lake/Prudenville, about 30 mins – multiple options
 - Cadillac, about 40 mins – multiple options
- Closest EV Charging Stations: we have EV charging capabilities for both vehicles and bikes as long as the guests provide their own adapter. Please message us through Airbnb if you need more details for onsite EV charging. Otherwise, there is an EV charging station at Rogers Family Foods in Lake City and several options in Houghton Lake, Grayling or Cadillac.

Check-Out Instructions

We hope you had a wonderful, relaxing stay! To help us prepare the RV perfectly for our next guests, please complete these quick steps by your agreed-upon check-out time:

 Linens & Towels: Please place all used bath towels, washcloths, and hand towels directly into the shower basin. You can leave the bed linens as they are.

 Trash Disposal: Securely bag all trash from the kitchen and bathroom, and place the bags into the large outdoor bin to prevent attracting wildlife.

 Power Down: Double-check that all lights, ceiling vent fans, the kitchen stove burners, and the electric fireplace are completely turned OFF.

 Secure the RV: Make sure all windows are completely closed.

 Final Sweep: Do one last walkthrough of the bedroom drawers, closets, and outlets to ensure you haven't forgotten any personal belongings or device chargers!

 Keys & Departure: Place the keys directly on the kitchen island and leave the RV door unlocked. After exiting, please push the door firmly until you hear it click to ensure it is securely latched against the weather and wind.
